The Setting...

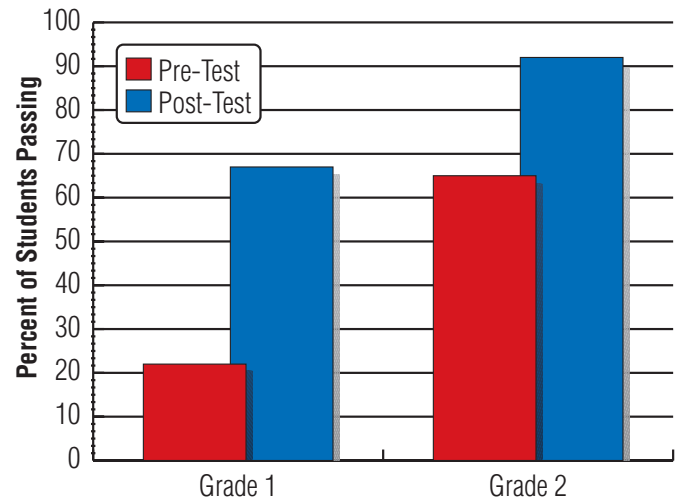
Where: Elementary schools throughout Arlington I.S.D. in Texas.

When: During a summer school program administered after the 2000-2001 school year.

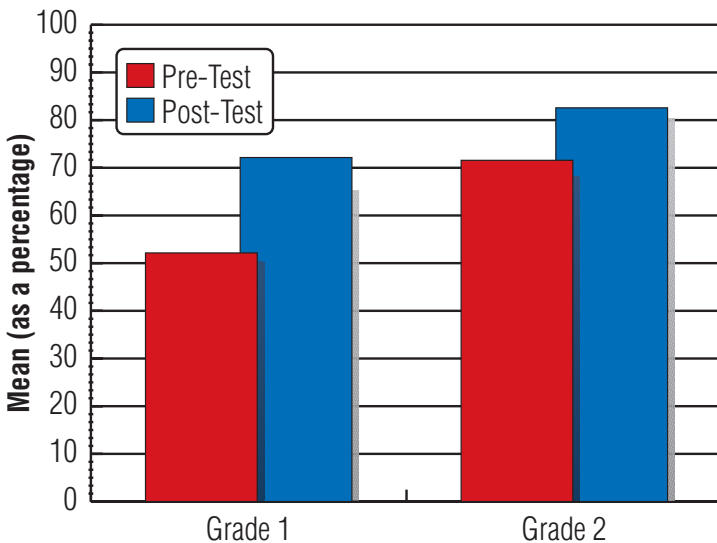
Purpose: To use the *Moviéndose con Matemáticas® Extensiones* math program to raise passing rates.

Change in Total Passing Rate for Grades 1 to 2



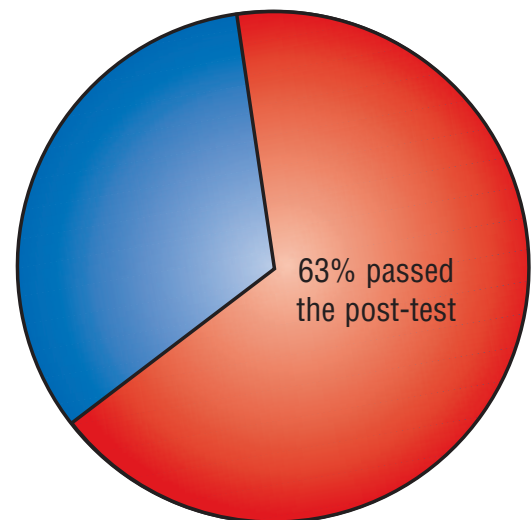
The overall percent of increase in passing students in Grades 1 and 2 increased 118%. Grade 1 increased by 205%!

Change in Mean Scores Pre-Test to Post-Test



The percent of increase in mean scores was 24%. The average gain for each student was 43%.

Success (Passing Rates) for Pupils Who Were Not Passing



Of those students who did not pass the pre-test, 63% passed the post-test.
